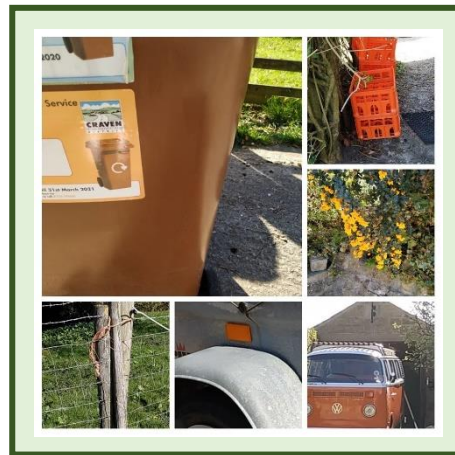


# RAINBOW WALK
