













Paint your own Blossom Tree and bring Outside Inside!

			
<p>1. Begin by drawing the tree trunk using pencil.</p>	<p>2. Add the main branches.</p>	<p>3. Finish the branches with narrowing tips.</p>	<p>4. Add layers of sky and strips of earth to form your background.</p>
			
<p>5. Paint the sky and layers of earth.</p>	<p>6. Add a medium brown shade for your tree.</p>	<p>7. Paint on dark and light brown to create texture on the trunk and branches.</p>	<p>8. Use small brush strokes to create shades and texture in the grass.</p>
			
<p>9. Finish any details using different tones of the same colour. You can add lots or a small amount it is up to you.</p>	<p>10. Mix a very pale pink and dab the blossom on and over the branches.</p>	<p>11. Using dark and light green add leaves and stalks for your blossom.</p>	<p>12. Add any other details to enhance your painting. Try using the work of artists such as David Hockney for inspiration.</p>
