


Asking interesting questions

Can you make a list of people you would like to find out more about? This list can be as long or as short as you want it to be. You can write it down or talk about it with a family member.




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My list of people I would like to find out more about:



Pick one of the people on your list. What do you already know about them?


Favourite food, favourite colour, places they like to visit...



What could you do to find out EVEN more?


CURIOUSITY QUESTIONS

If you are **curious**, you are eager to learn or know something.



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CURIOUSITY QUESTIONS


You will already know lots about the people on your list, but you could use this opportunity to find out even more about them. There are two type of questions you could choose to ask:

Open Questions: these will give you different answers, and these will normally be answers you wouldn't be able to guess.

e.g. If you could travel anywhere in the world, where would you go?

Closed Questions: you might be able to guess the answer and the answer itself might only be one word
e.g. Which do you prefer chocolate or sweets?

Before you think of some questions to send to your family and friends, let's look at some questions from this book called 'You Choose'. You can practice answering some questions yourselves and you might even choose to send some of these to the people on your list!



Is there a job you would like to do?



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
What do you like to do for fun?



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Here are some more questions:


If you could choose any superhero power, which one would you choose and why?

Here are just some ideas of ways you can send your Curiosity Questions to your family and friends:

- Write a note
- Make a video
- Send a voice note
- Make a poster of your questions and take a photograph

Ask them to send you some questions too so that you can keep the conversation going!
