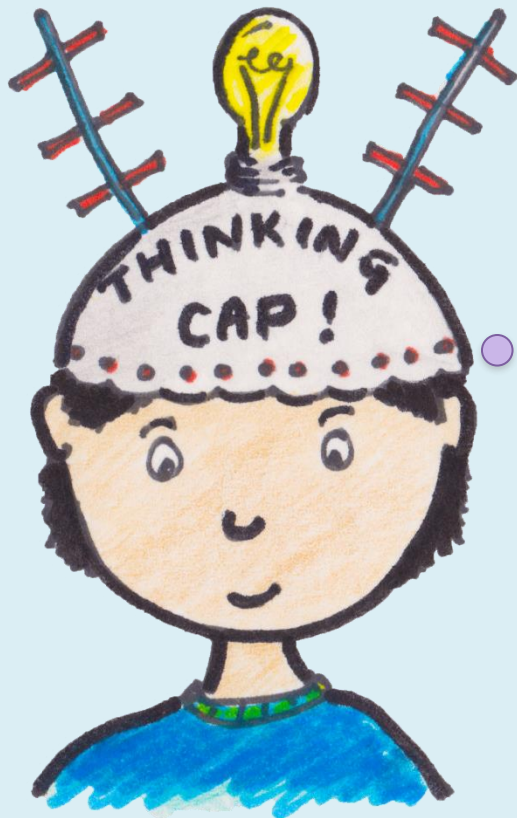

Getting Started

1. Think about the things that you love in the world, things that are special to you. Making a list can sometimes help you to remember all your ideas.
2. Using some paper or card cut yourself  some triangles to use for your bunting designs, add some holes to hang up your work.
3. Now decide what you want to put on your bunting, you can cut out designs from packages, paint, draw, doodle anything you like.
