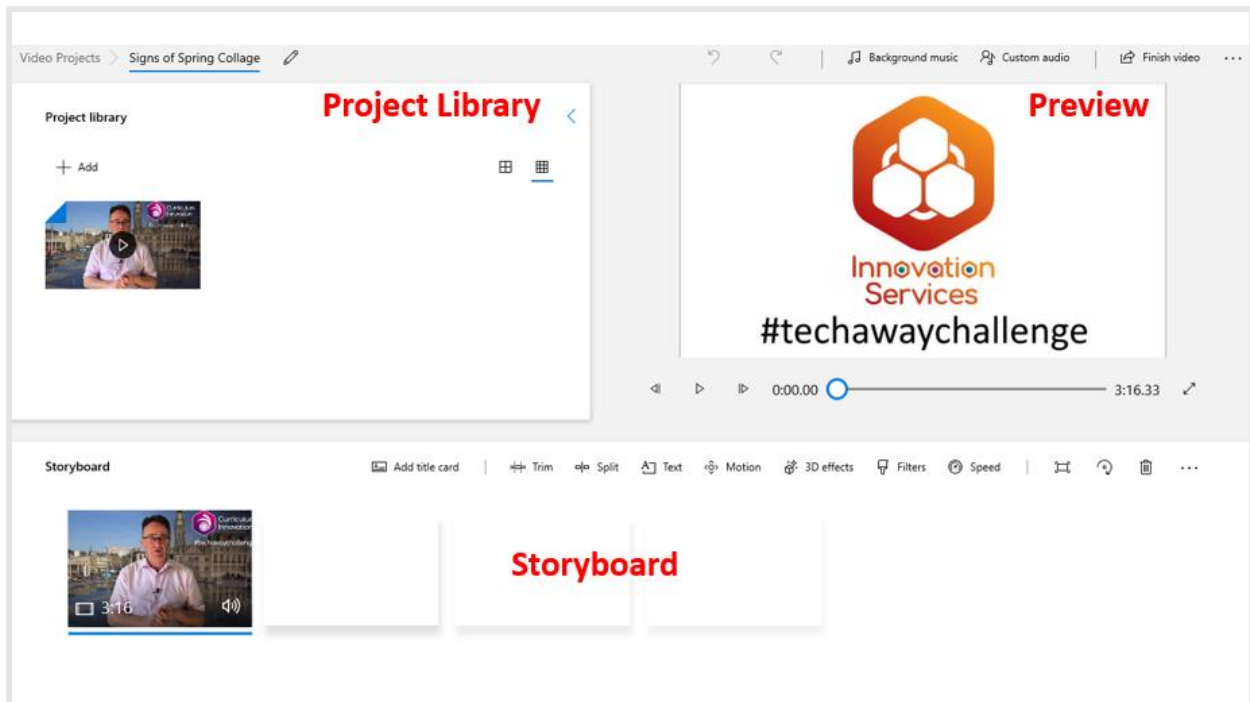


Video Editing with the Windows 10 Photos App

- Go to Video Projects and click New Video Project.
- Name the project.
- Add your videos by clicking the add button in the Project area and browsing the area where you saved them on your computer.
- Drag the clips onto the Storyboard area in the sequence you'd like to use them.
- To cut the start or the end of a clip click on it then click trim. Now slide the arrows in to leave the parts of the video you need. Click Done when you have finished.
- The editing tools in the Storyboard area also let you rotate a clip if it has been filmed the wrong way round. You can change the speed, add text or change filters.
- To add text on a background rather than over a video choose Add Title Card.
- To adjust the volume of a clip, click on the speaker in the clip in the Storyboard area.
- To add music click Add Background Music at the top right-hand corner of the screen. Note that you have to add this music to the whole project.
- There isn't a built-in narration tool. You can use the Windows 10 Voice Recorder, save the recording then choose Custom Audio in the top right.
- To share the finished video Click Finish Video in the top right. Now save your finished video to the destination folder of your choice.

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
